- 5. To ensure the privacy and security of electronic information and data.
- 6. To provide training and professional development opportunities.
- 7. To promote digital literacy among students, faculty, and staff.

Code of Ethics for IT:

This policy includes a code of ethics for the use of IT, which outlines the responsibilities of users to:

The following principles should guide the use of IT in the college:

- · Use technology in an ethical and responsible manner
- · Respect the privacy and security of electronic information and data
- · Avoid using technology for illegal activities
- · Responsible use of hardware and software resources.
- IT resources must be used for educational and research purposes only.
- · Responsibility for one's own actions and decisions when using IT.

IT Policy:
